National FFA Alumni Convention was held in Louisville, KY in conjunction with the National FFA Convention in October. For those who have never been, there are many activities throughout the National FFA Convention that make it an event well worth your time.

Starting Wednesday and running through every day of convention, FFA Alumni has a booth at the FFA Expo that includes handouts for FFA members, parents, and alumni and is staffed by national FFA alumni board members who are able to answer questions and have conversations with those looking to start their own local alumni.
